


Draft Recommendation on Ethics

 - Explainability & Transparency




Draft Recommendation on Ethics of Al

Draft Recommendation on Ethics of Al

- Submitted for Adoption by UNESCO's 41st General Conference in Nov. 2021
- Aims

 - Policy Advice across 11 policy areas
 - Ethical impact assessment tool
 - Al readiness methodology
 - Capacity building executive, legislature, judiciary






Al Microlearning for Youth


International Women's Day 2021

 Confronted the deep-rooted gender imbalances that impact AI






Effects of AI on Women in the Workforce (2022)

Al Needs Assessment Survey in Africa


Addresses gap in information on Al policies from Developing Countries




